

TOWER

Tower is a game of progressive deck building poker.

To play all you need is a standard deck of playing cards and a basic understanding of poker hands

Tower is played in two stages.

The pyramid:



The tower:

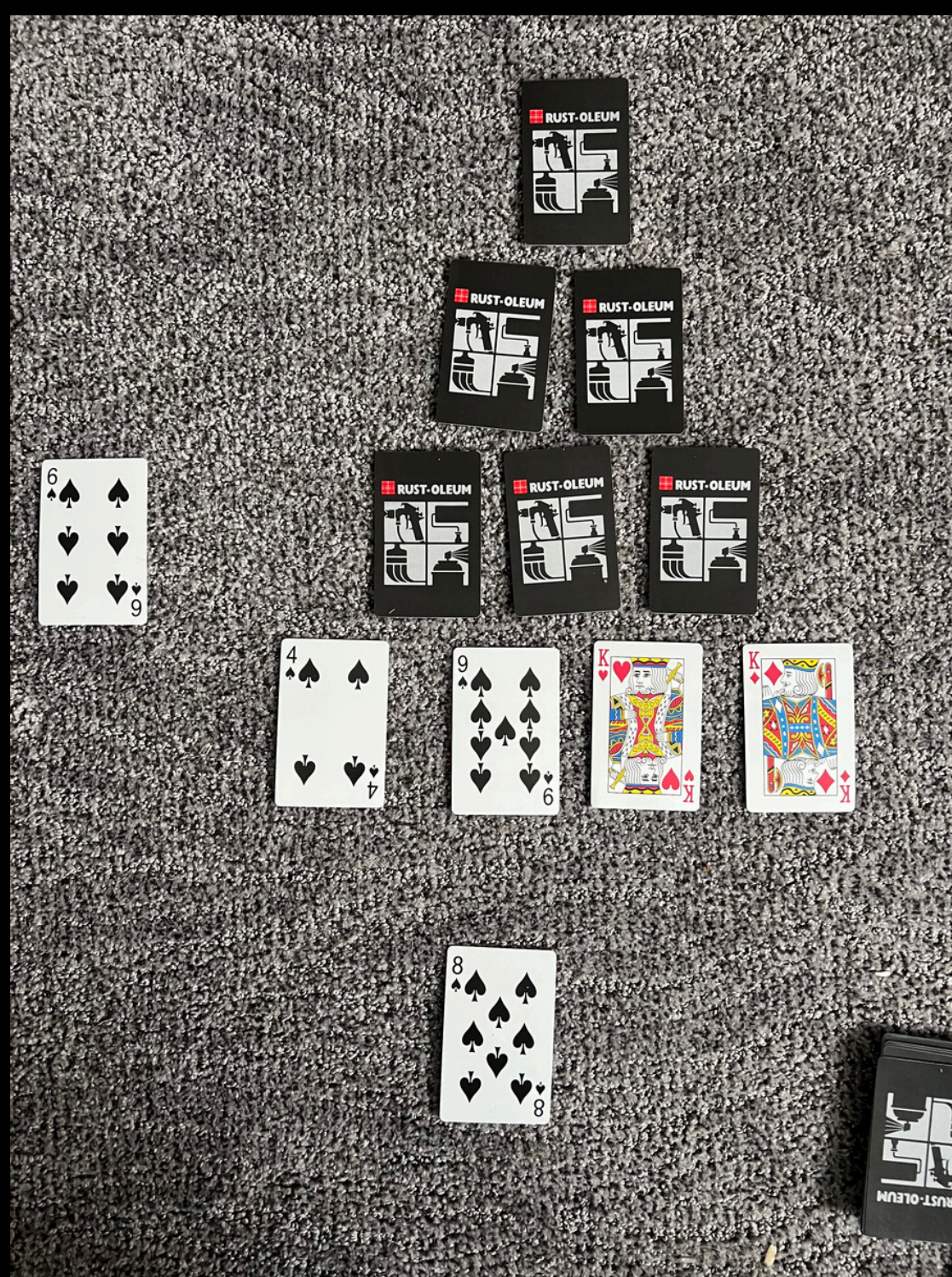


The pyramid is played first to allow you to build up your hand for the tower.

The pyramid is set up using 10 cards set into 4 rows.
4 cards on the bottom row, 3 on the next and so on.
The cards are set face down.



Each player is dealt one card.
The bottom row of the pyramid is then flipped.



This is your hand.

The winner of the round is decided by whoever has the best poker hand.
In the example above the bottom hand would have won by high card.
The winner of the round now has the option to keep the furthest right
card in the row.

In this example they would be able to keep the king.

This card is known as the cornerstone.

If the winner of the round takes the card they are not dealt another card
during the next row.



The row of cards is then discarded.

This process is repeated until the pyramid is complete.



Now that the pyramid is completed the tower can be built.
Each player should now have 5 cards in their hand.
The tower built by taking 3 cards and placing them vertically.



The players then play their hands.
The hand will be the best 5 card combo they can come up with using the cards in their hand and in the tower.
If you were able to build a powerful hand during the pyramid stage you do not have to use any of the cards from the tower.
In this case above, the hand on the left would have won with the 2 pair.

**The only round that matters is the tower round.
You can win every round of the pyramid but if you lose the tower round then you didn't win the match
The pyramid rounds are purely for building your deck for the tower round**

The winner of the tower is granted the option to keep a card from the tower to start with during the next round. However, they cannot keep both the card from the tower and the card they were dealt, one must be discarded after the initial flip of the bottom row.



The cards are then passed to the person to your left and they get to deal the next match
